RE: UPDATE: TRAILS at MILLSTREAM CREEK AND CAL REVELLE NATURE RESERVE

Millstream Creek: Approving Officer will be providing a trails status update to SSSC. SLUSC Chair, Allan Roger will probably request a site visit from developer when he returns from holiday.

Cal Revelle Nature Reserve: tree cutting and trail building/expansion (used by both mountain bikes and motorized bikes) has been occurring over the last two years. Local residents have expressed concern. SSSC will be organizing an inspection walk soon and will notify SLUSC of dates.
