


1. Download the Leapfrog Viewer and open a viewer file (.lfview file).

2. Drawing a Slice

- Use the Keyboard shortcut “D” to look vertically down on the model.
- Click the slice button. 
- Click and Drag from the starting point to the end point of desired slice.
- To look directly at slice plane: keyboard shortcuts “L” and Shift “L” will orient the view facing the slicing plane. Move the Slicing Plane backwards/forwards using “< >” keys
- Change slice properties in the Slicing plane panel. Options include Thick Slice, Remove Front, Remove Back.

| Change the viewing angle, i.e orbit the model | Hold the Left mouse button while moving the mouse. Use the Look menu to switch to different viewing angles. | Arrow keys + Shift key for smaller steps |
| Zoom in and out | <i>Fast:</i> Scroll wheel <i>Slow:</i> Right mouse click and drag. | Page Up and Page Down keys + Shift key for smaller steps |
| Pan the model | Click and hold both buttons and drag OR Hold the scroll wheel and drag. | Arrow keys + Alt key |
| View shortcuts | “L” or Shift “L” to look at either side of the plane N = look North, S = South, E = East, W = West, U = Up, D = Down | |
