

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

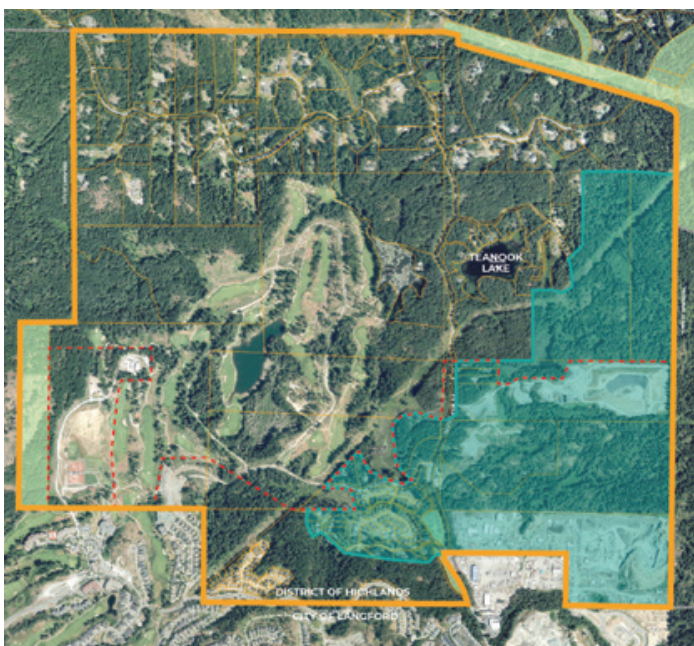
